Day	Description			
Day1	Meet at Manas airport. Bus to the guest house ~40min (25km). Bishkek City tour. Overnight in the guest house (Elevation: 900m).			
Day2	Leaving the guest house you will travel to Jeti-Oguz ~6-7 hours (390km). On the way you will visit Burana tower. Overnight in the yurt camp (Elevation: 2300m).			
Day3	Leaving the yurt camp you will travel to Echkilitash valley ~5-6 hours (150km). You will hike to Tyuz pass (4001m) ~2-3 hours (8km). Overnight in the tent (Elevation: 3180m).			
Day4	Leaving the campsite you will hike to the baseline Tyuz pass ~5-6 hours (12km). On the way you will make a river crossing through the Tyuz River. Overnight in the tent (Elevation: 3285m).			
Day5	Leaving the campsite you will summit Tyuz pass (4001m) and descend Enilchek valley ~7-8 hours (16km). Overnight in the tent (Elevation: 2900m).			
Day6	Leaving the campsite you will hike on Enilchek glacier down to the campsite Glinaya Polyana ~5-6 hours (8km). Overnight in the tent (Elevation: 3380m).			
Day7	Leaving the campsite you will hike to the campsite Polyana Merzbacher ~4-5 hours (8km). Overnight in the tent (Elevation: 3550m).			
Day8	Free day in the camp, after the breakfast you can hike around the Merzbacher lake and return to the campsite ~5-6 hours (8km). Overnight in the tents (Elevation: 3550m).			
Day9	Leaving the campsite you hike ~6-7 hours (15km) on Enilchek glacier till the confluence of two glaciers: Proletarski and Enilchek. Overnight in the tents (Elevation: 3800m).			
Day10	Leaving campsite you will hike over Enilcheck glacier to where it joins Dikiy glacier ~5-6 hours (10km). Overnight in the tent (Elevation: 3850m).			
Day11	Leaving the campsite you will hike ~5-6 hours (10km) to the base camp between peaks Khan-Tengri (6995m) and Pobeda (7439m). Overnight in the tents (Elevation: 4000m).			
Day12	Leaving the campsite you will approach the baseline of peak Khan-Tengri (6995m) ~7-8 hours (16km). Overnight in the tents (Elevation: 4000m).			
Day13	Leaving the campsite you will hike down Enilchek glacier (3900m) ~7-8 hours (16km). Overnight in the tent (Elevation: 3780m).			
Day14	Leaving the campsite you will hike down Enilchek glacier to the campsite Glinaya Polyana ~7-8 hours (16km). Overnight in the tent (Elevation: 3380m).			
Day15	Leaving the campsite you will hike down Enilchek glacier to the campsite Prizim ~6-7 hours (14km). Overnight in the tent (Elevation: 2850m).			
Day16	Leaving the campsite you will hike down to Atjailoo valley along Enilchek river ~3-4 hours (10km). On the way you will make a river crossing. You will travel to Karakol ~5-6 hours (180km). Overnight in the guest house (Elevation: 1670m).			
Day17	Leaving the guest house will be travel to Tamga village ~2-3 hours (70km). Overnight in the guest house (Elevation: 1700m).			
Day18	Leaving the guest house you will be travel to Kochkor village ~3-4 hours (180km). On the way you will hike through Fairy Tale canyon ~1-2 hours (~5km). Overnight in the guest house (Elevation: 1767m).			
Day19	Leaving the guest house you will travel to Son-Kul lake ~3 hours (60km). Overnight in the yurt camp (Elevation: 3000m).			
Day20	Leaving the yurt camp you will travel to Bishkek ~7-8 (320km). Overnight in the guest house (Elevation: 900m).			
Day21	Leaving the guest house you will travel to Manas airport ~40min (25km).

# **Additional information**

# Personnel

The price listed above includes food, rental equipment and transportation for the personnel.

EcoTrek will provide an experienced mountain guide. The guides are all well educated in trekking and mountain safety.

EcoTrek will provide one **porter** for each client. The porters can carry up to 17 kilos. The porters will carry all food and camping equipment for the entire trek. Typically our clients carry a small backpack which contains water, snacks, and 1 or 2 items of clothing during the trek. An additional porter can be provided for €23 per day.

EcoTrek will provide a professional **mountain cook**. The cook will prepare fresh and nutritious food for the trek. Please inform your cook if you are a vegetarian or have any allergies. If there are more than 7 clients, a mountain cook assistant is provided.

### Climate

Kyrgyzstan has a continental climate. The sun shines over 200 days a year. The temperature during the summer months can range from 20°C to 40°C between 900-2000m elevations; between 3000-4000 m the temperature ranges from 0°C to 20°C. In Kyrgyzstan the weather can change 3-4 times a day. Be aware sometimes you may experience rainy, snowy and sunny weather in the same day.

# You need to bring:

Winter jacket, sleeping bag rated for -26°C to 0°C, rain gear, 2-3 pairs of wool socks, waterproof trekking boots, gloves, sunglasses, sunscreen with high UV-protection, lip balm with UV-protection.

# EcoTrek will provide the necessary trekking equipment:

A 2 person 3 season tent and a sleeping mat. EcoTrek will also provide a kitchen for the cook and dining area for the clients to eat their meals. If client wants to stay in single tent there is a cost of  $\in$ 4 per day.

# Food during the trek

Breakfast: hot cereal or fried eggs, cheese, honey, bread, butter, coffee and tea.

Lunch: salads, sandwiches, fruit, coffee and tea.

Snack: cookies, coffee and tea.

Dinner: soup, second course, cheese, honey, dried fruit, bread, coffee and tea.

### **Insurance**

It is strongly recommended that all clients have proper insurance to cover any illnesses, helicopter evacuation and transportation to their country of origin. In the event of an emergency EcoTrek will do everything in its power to assist clients. Please contact your Embassy to find the best travelers insurance policy for your stay in Kyrgyzstan.

#### Visa

Kyrgyz Republic gives free visa to citizens of 44 countries including; EU, USA, Japan, UK, Norway, Switzerland and Brazil.

# Terms & Conditions

EcoTrek needs to be paid in full before the trek starts. If the client cancels the trek before the agreed upon start date, EcoTrek will keep a 15 % cancelation fee. Clients who return early from a trek are not eligible for a refund for the personnel/food unless injury, illness or natural events forces the trek to end early.

All prices are listed in EUROS and these prices are valid throughout 2015. EcoTrek will prepare a receipt for the payment. Please note that bank transfers will cost an additional 7 % for the transaction fee. We request that a 15% deposit is paid 15 days before the start of the trek.
